

Morwell Central Primary School Uniform Policy 2024

Rationale:

Morwell Central Primary School has a compulsory school uniform that children are required to wear:

- during school hours,
- while travelling to and from school
- when engaged in school activities off site
- when engaged in school activities out of school hours

Uniform:

Acceptable clothing guidelines for all school activities:

- Shoes need to be appropriate for school activities. Open-toed shoes, sandals and thongs are considered dangerous and therefore inappropriate. Sneakers are acceptable.
- Jewellery is considered unnecessary and inappropriate. Only studs and small sleepers in ears are considered an appropriate type of earring for school, due to safety considerations.
- No student is to have a facial or body piercing, due to safety considerations.
- Hair Students with long hair are strongly encouraged to wear it tied back and it must not be dyed an unnatural colour.
- Jewellery, nails, hair accessories and similar items that interfere with students' ability to engage with school activities safely and fully are not permitted.
- Students are not allowed to wear make-up.
- Other than clear nail polish, cosmetics and fake nails may not be worn at school.

• The only hats that are acceptable are Sunsmart school hats consistent with our Sunsmart policy. They must be worn outside in Terms 1 & 4 and in Terms 2 and 3 when the UV levels are above recommended levels. Hats are not to be worn inside.
